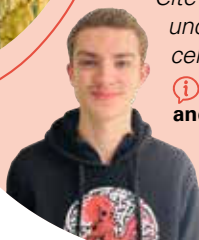


TOUR OF THE UNDERGROUND CELLARS OF BAZAS

CADILLAC

A CHARMING HISTORIC TOWN

On the banks of the Garonne, in 1280, the bastide town of Cadillac was founded by Lord Jean de Grailly with the support of the King of England, in order to block the advance of the French armies. From its 14th-century fortifications, it still retains impressive remains, along with its original street plan laid out in rectangular blocks.

The best way to explore the town is on foot – leave your car by the ramparts and take a stroll through the old streets, making sure not to miss the splendid Château of the Dukes of Épernon (a listed national monument). And don't forget: the vineyards of Cadillac-sur-Garonne produce a renowned wine that you really should discover at the Maison des Vins de Cadillac's ecomuseum – and during the vineyard evenings held there in summer.



Audio-guided tours

As close to the locals as it gets, Nelly invites you on an audio-guided walk to share stories you won't necessarily find in the history books.

You're in control — using your own phone and headphones, you're free to explore the town at your own pace, whenever it suits you.

THE CEMETERY OF THE FORGOTTEN AND THE GRAVEDIGGER'S HOUSE

«The Cemetery of the Forgotten was created in 1923 to receive the bodies of soldiers from the First World War who had been interned, traumatised by the fighting, and who died in the psychiatric hospital of Cadillac-sur-Garonne.»



In the Gironde region, Cadillac's cemetery is one of the very few in France to bear witness to this tragic chapter of history.

It stands as a major site of remembrance, honouring these war-torn soldiers, the forgotten "broken faces" — those "wounded in the mind".»

Did you know?

ANTOINE DE LAMOTHE, SIEUR DE CADILLAC

A Gascon gentleman and squire, Antoine de Lamothe was born in Saint-Nicolas-de-la-Grave (Tarn-et-Garonne) in 1658. Knighted for his military service and a devoted admirer of the valiant Duke of Épernon, Antoine took the title sieur de Cadillac.

Once in America, he developed a plan to establish a settlement on the right bank of the Detroit River, aiming to open trade routes with Louisiana via the Mississippi.

In 1701, he took possession of Detroit, where he built Fort Pontchartrain. In 1710, he was appointed Governor of Louisiana.

In 1902, Henry Martyn Leland, along with W. Murphy and W. Bowen, founded the Cadillac Automobile Company in tribute to the founder of the city of Detroit, whose 200th anniversary had just been celebrated.

The first Cadillac car was released in 1903.



THE MEDIEVAL CHARM OF SAINT-MACAIRE

Here you are, setting off on a non-stop journey back to the Middle Ages! Wandering through the picturesque little streets is a real delight, with steep stairways to climb that spark childhood memories – and breathtaking views over the Mercadiou and the old fortifications, proud symbols of the town's once-powerful merchant class.



Guided tours

For two hours, discover the exceptional heritage of this former merchant town: its ramparts, the Church of Saint-Sauveur with its 13th-century wall paintings, merchants' houses, the Mercadiou, and more.

Tours take place on Thursdays at 10:30am from June to September. At 3pm, fun family-friendly tours are offered on Thursdays during the summer holidays.

One of a kind

THE REMARKABLE TREE

The Négundo maple, officially recognised as a "Remarkable Tree", stands out for its exceptional size (4.80 m in circumference at 1.30 m above the ground). Old postcards confirm its presence before 1906, even though the average lifespan of an *Acer negundo* is just 80 years. It has a complex structure, with roots growing inside the trunk and a colonial form made up of several independent functional units. Its ecological and heritage value is considerable.

Le Paillet

This Gascon term refers to a stilted barn located on the banks of the Garonne. Its raised position made it possible to store straw safely, protected from the floods of Dame Garonne. Restored a few years ago thanks to a volunteer-led project, this 19th-century structure has now regained its original appearance.

THE TOURIST OFFICE WINE CELLAR

Keen to discover the wines of the Côtes de Bordeaux Saint-Macaire appellation? At the Tourist Office wine cellar, you'll be spoilt for choice with over 100 different wines! Red, rosé, dry white, sweet and dessert wines — even Bordeaux crémant — all from local family-run estates on the right bank slopes of the Garonne.

The added bonus: meet the winemakers during tasting events held in July and August.

BORDEAUX'S GODDAUGHTER

Visit Rions, nestled at the foot of the right-bank slopes of the Garonne, in the heart of the Cadillac Côtes de Bordeaux vineyards.

Then head up into the hills, where you'll find many small châteaux among the vines and enjoy panoramic views over the town and the Garonne River.



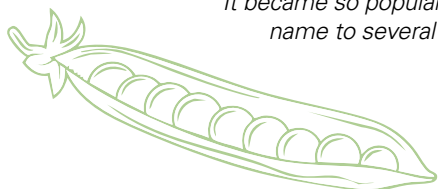

THE LITTLE PEA MARKET HALL


"Mixed farming was a common practice among our elders. As they ploughed between the vine rows, they would take the opportunity to sow the little green seed, increasing both their yield and their income. The pea, a symbol and source of pride for the village, naturally emerged as an emblem. It became so popular in the area that it gave its name to several markets — and eventually, to their market hall."

THE PEOPLE'S CLUB OF RIONS

A monthly programme runs all year round: a concert with a "plate & music" format, and a variety of events — either in partnership with other local associations (talks, writing workshops, board games with a nearby toy library), or organised by members themselves (bike repairs, Scrabble afternoons, chess, wine tastings, festive Sundays featuring oysters, garbure, and more...)

WHISPERED IN

Little Stories Within the Big Story –
La Gironde du Sud has plenty of them tucked away!
Here are a few tales... but which ones are true?

Hostens – From coal to white sand

Beneath the calm waters of the Hostens lakes lies a part of our **industrial past**. This story began in 1930 with **the mining of lignite**, a cousin of coal, by the Société Minière et Électrique des Landes. Over the years, the pace of extraction led to the depletion of the deposit, until the site finally closed in 1966. Bought by the Conseil Général in the late 1960s, the land was restored and, by 1976, welcomed the first visitors to what is now a leisure park.



The Treasure of Bazas

In May 2004, a builder was carrying out renovation work in his home in the historic centre of Bazas when he made an incredible discovery: nearly a thousand coins had been hidden for almost six centuries inside one of his walls! **The 1,010 coins — gold, silver, and billon from the 15th century** — were later sold at auction. A few of these marvels can still be seen at the town's municipal museum.



Queen Margot's cave

Legend has it that in 1783, King Henry IV placed **Queen Margot** under house arrest while awaiting the annulment of their marriage, as she was unable to produce an heir. To pass the time, the queen would take **the underground passage** from the moat to reach the caves — where she would meet her lovers.

Entry to the park is subject to a fee. However, with any guided tour of the château, park access is included.



The legend of the matron

It is said that a woman from Bazas witnessed **the beheading of Saint John the Baptist** in Jerusalem. She is believed to have brought back **a few drops of his blood** on a piece of cloth, which she placed in a small vial. She then returned to Bazas and placed the relic in the cathedral that bears the saint's name.



YOUR EAR...



The mule's footstep of Verdelaïs

Around 1295, during **the war against the English**, the chapel of Verdelaïs was looted and burned... **The statue of the Virgin Mary was hidden** and buried in a sealed vault underground.

Countess Isabelle de Foix (1360–1428), while visiting her lands around 1390 and crossing the woods, found the statue's hiding place thanks to her mule, and decided to have a new chapel built.

Lake Troupins

At the northern edge of the commune of Guillos, between Hostens and Podensac, lies **a vast stretch of water**. A peaceful spot, just a few metres from the D115 road. Welcome to Lake Troupins — a true haven of tranquillity...

Yet a strange tale has been passed down through generations. A curious legend...

It is said that a man, along with his cart and oxen, was swallowed up in the middle of the lake.

A whirlpool is said to have dragged them all into the depths of the southern Gironde moorlands — without mercy... But the twist? He supposedly reappeared in Biscarrosse!



The birth of the sweet wines of Sainte-Croix-du-Mont

What a strange idea — **making wine from rotten grapes!** And yet, that's exactly what the Lord of Tastes is said to have done. Having left for the Crusades, he returned too late for the grape harvest. Not wanting to waste his crop, he decided to pick the grapes anyway and make wine.

To his great surprise, he had just discovered **a sweet white wine** that would go on to make Sainte-Croix-du-Mont famous.

A hero fallen from the sky

On 5 March 1944, **an American plane was shot down** over Romestaing and Cours-les-Bains, south of Grignols. Its pilot, young Chuck Yeager — who would later become the first man to break the sound barrier — **was taken in by the Resistance**. To escape the Germans, he swapped his uniform for a suit belonging to a local man who had gone off to war.

Grateful, Yeager returned several times to thank his rescuers. Even today, the story of his escape — and the mysterious suit — continues to fuel local legend.

1 Historic footsteps

📍 Verdélais

Ready for a deep breath of history? Let's go! **A basilica and its stunning square**, trodden by thousands of pilgrims since the Middle Ages. **A way of the cross** with 14 chapels and a calvary. The restored **cussol windmill**. **The mule's footprint** and its legend. The presence of François Mauriac. **The tomb of Toulouse-Lautrec**. Still got some energy left? Head to the **Museum of sacred art** and its remarkable collection of painted ex-votos dedicated to Notre-Dame de Verdélais (visits on request). Phew!

The Gallo-Roman Villa

📍 Loupiac

As a retired winegrower, I invite you to explore the **remarkable remains** of this site, passed down to me by my parents.

The Saint-Romain site includes **a Gallo-Roman villa** with buildings dating from the 1st to the 7th century AD, **a 12th-century priory**, and **an 18th-century residence**.

You'll be amazed by the thermal complex, especially the **natatio**, bordered by a mosaic-covered gallery rich in vibrant colours.

Le Domaine du Parc Chavat

📍 Podensac

Le Domaine du Parc Chavat overlooks the Garonne and stands out for its **remarkable plant diversity**, its many sculptures, and its water features. Abandoned in the late 19th century, the estate owes its revival to a man of great taste: **François Thévenot**, who acquired the property in 1914 **to save it from ruin and transform it into a jardin remarquable**. It is considered by the Monuments Historiques as one of **the finest parks in Aquitaine**.

4 La Chapelle de Brax

Landiras



Let me take you deep into the forest, where **a fascinating building awaits: the "church of the marshes"**. Fully restored since 2022, La Chapelle de Brax dates back to the 13th century. Its name, spelled "Brach" until the Revolution, is thought to come from the Gaulish word bracu, meaning marsh. Tucked away in a small aerial — a traditional clearing in the Landes forest — deep in the woods between Saint-Michel and Landiras, once known only to a few mushroom hunters, it offers a real sense of serenity. **Whether as a cool, peaceful stop or a cultural venue**, La Chapelle de Brax hosts a variety of performances — both from nature and from people — with a dedicated **events programme** celebrating the space.

5 La fontaine Saint-Clair

Saint-Léger de Balson



This fountain is one of the special features of our little village in the Landes de Gascogne. Located to the south-east of the church, near the Hure stream, **the spring dedicated to Saint-Clair** is believed **to cure aches** and a range of other ailments. Even today, it remains a place of **pilgrimage** for people from neighbouring villages, who have great faith in the healing powers of its waters.

The inspiring Château de La Brède

Behind the walls of this prestigious building, you will discover **the story of a family — that of Charles-Louis de Secondat, Montesquieu**, born here in 1689. He grew up here and returned often throughout his life. The château dates back to the 11th century, and Montesquieu made few alterations to the building itself. Instead, he focused on designing the surrounding grounds, creating a magnificent estate, now classified as a Historic Monument.

Château de Budos



Budos

Built in the 14th century for a nephew of Pope Clement V, Raymond Guilhem, the Château de Budos is both a palace and a fortress. A victim of revolutionary events and the ravages of time, it is now being restored thanks to volunteer work and activities organised by the Adichats association.

ITS SPECIAL FEATURE

Declared national property during the Revolution, it was dismantled and used as a quarry.

THE PLUS

The building is contemporary to the Château de Villandraut and was constructed with the same architectural design. One could say it's its cousin!

Château Ducal



Cadillac

Built as a palace starting in 1599 by the Duke of Épernon, the building long represented the power of its owners before being dismantled in the 18th century and, in the early 19th century, becoming a prison. First a women's prison, then a «school for the preservation of young girls,» and later a reform school until the 1950s, the château is now one of the most important monuments in Gironde.

ITS SPECIAL FEATURE

It is the first example of French-style architecture.

THE PLUS

The site hosts exhibitions, performances, and... your events! You can even organise an Arty'versaïre for your child there.

Château du Hamel



Castets-et-Castillon

Feudal and Renaissance styles brought together in one place! The current buildings date back to the 16th century, but they rest on the foundations of a fortified site built in the 14th century. Henri IV stayed here in 1585.

The tour is led by the owners themselves. Together, they enjoy taking the time to tell the story of the château, comfortably seated under a beautiful tree in the park.

Château de Langoiran



Langoiran

A royal fortress at the end of the 15th century, involved in the struggles between the Kings of England and France during the Hundred Years' War, and later a residence for the Presidents of the Bordeaux Parliament in the 15th and 17th centuries, the Château de Langoiran has undergone fabulous restorations..

Stay in a medieval atmosphere with the château's guest rooms and gîtes.

Château fort de Roquetaillade

Mazères

Inhabited by the same family since 1306, it is one of the 10 most beautiful castles in France.

Behind its austere medieval facades, you'll find the colorful world of the great architect Viollet-le-Duc. A true cinematic backdrop that has hosted Fantômas, Louis de Funès, and Roger Moore.

Château royal de Cazeneuve

Prézac

Known for being the residence of the Kings of Navarre, this beautiful example of a medieval castle overlooks the Ciron valley. The Lords of Albret lived here from the 13th century, followed by illustrious owners, the most famous of whom was Henri IV.

ITS SPECIAL FEATURE

Its medieval cellars house great Bordeaux vintages. The royal apartments are perfectly preserved and furnished with period furniture.

THE PLUS

The park, classified as a Historic Monument and Natura 2000 site, features vast umbrella pines, the Queen's Cave, and a bamboo grove over 100 years old.

Château de Malle

Preignac

The château is a private Historic Monument, built in the 18th century, surrounded by 6.5 hectares of remarkable gardens inspired by the famous creations of Louis XIV at Versailles. Behind its elegant façade, the interior reveals richly decorated salons, adorned with frescoes and period furniture, reflecting the refinement of the past.

ITS SPECIAL FEATURE

The estate has about fifty hectares of vineyards, producing Sauternes (sweet wine) and Graves (white and red). Since 1855, it has been a Second Grand Cru Classé de Sauternes..

Its French-style gardens, inspired by the Renaissance.

The tranquillity of greenways

Ah, the greenways... **Pedal, relax, admire...** all without cars nearby (or rarely)! In La Gironde du Sud, they bear evocative names that invite you to escape or challenge yourself. Let's start gently by following **the Garonne Canal** in Castets-et-Castillon. You have a choice: take a lovely 5 km loop or embark on an adventure all the way to Toulouse. Want to stay close to the water? Join us on the three green tracks **around the lakes in Hostens*** (8, 11, and 16 km). For a bit more challenge, there are additional red and black loops.

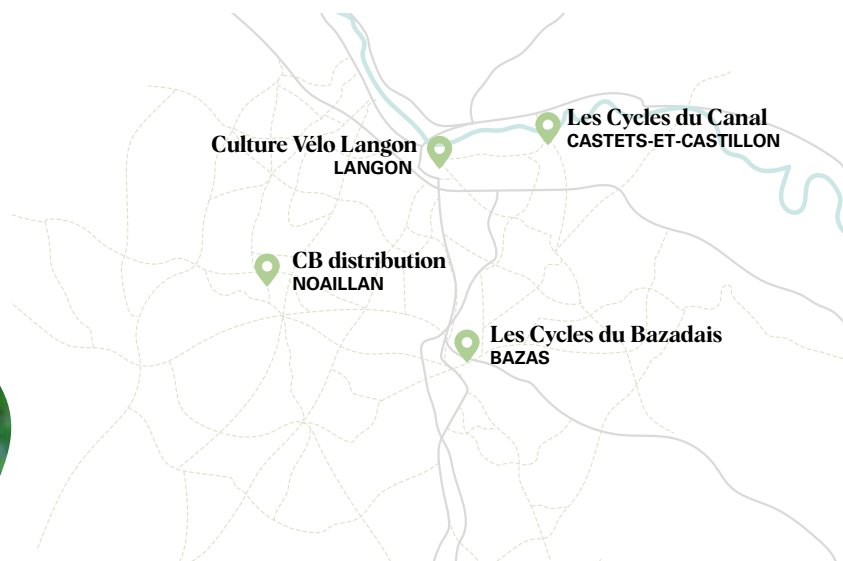

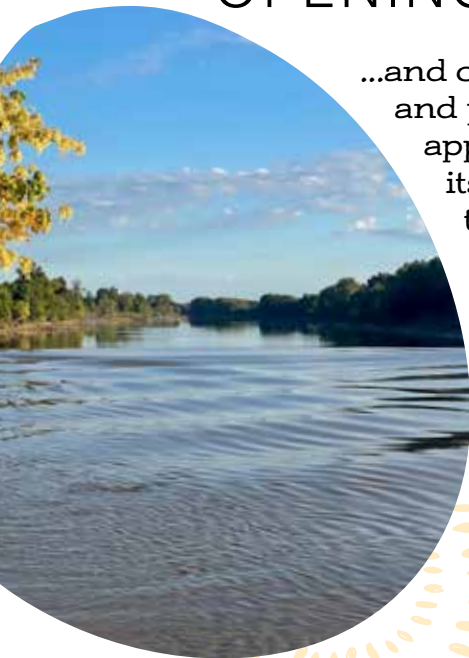

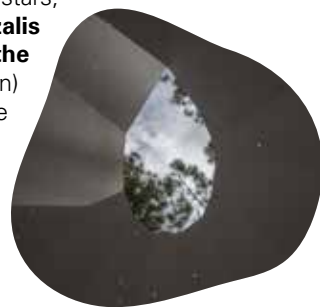

Have you heard of pine-tapping?

The job of a tapper involved collecting pine sap using a tool called an «hapchot».

The tree's resin, mixed with rainwater, would settle in a dedicated pot and form a liquid called «gemme», **used in the production of cosmetics and pharmaceuticals.** Imagine yourself, under the cool shade of the pines, stepping into the shoes of a tapper during a visit led by passionate experts. ENCHANTING GARONNE

Over 100 km, it originates in the Pyrenees and flows through Gironde. Sometimes tumultuous with legendary floods, the Garonne never stops shaping our landscapes and captivating us. Along its banks or on its waters, it invites us to explore. Who would dare decline such an enticing invitation? Not us!



The Mascaret ? What's that?

It's the rise in water level in an estuary caused by **the tidal wave**. This water enters and flows up the river from its mouth in the form of **a wave called the Mascaret**. Mostly imperceptible, the wave can reach up to two meters in height during high tides with a coefficient over 90, and can surge at speeds of up to 20 km/h.

Surfing the Mascaret

The «Mascaret» is **THE wave of the Garonne**, and like all waves worthy of the name, **it's perfect for gliding!**

With wetsuits on, surfers, kayakers, paddleboarders, and canoeists are many to ride the wave, which rolls slowly in a continuous gentle rustle, flowing upstream against the Garonne.

The poetry of the Canal de Garonne

Called the Canal de Garonne, the lateral canal to the Garonne runs from Castets-et-Castillon to Toulouse. It then becomes the Canal du Midi, finishing at Sète. The whole thing forms a beautiful blue ribbon known as **the Canal des deux Mers**. 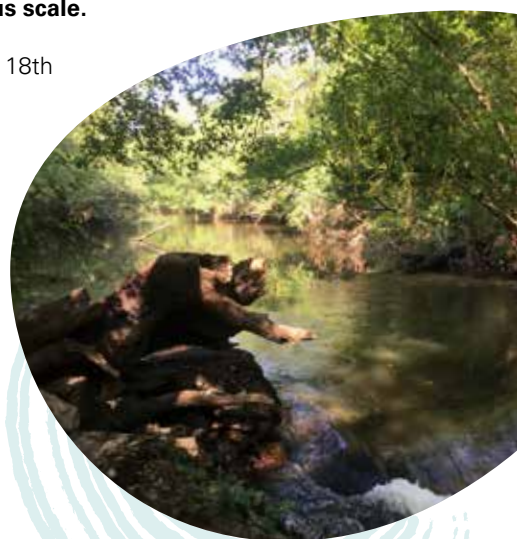
All the floods before your eyes
